Come and share the passion for Motorcycles, with a unique collection on show, ranging from 50cc to 1000cc including names like Paloma, Negrini, Malagutti, Hercules, Flandria, Hondamatic and below a 1921 French racing bike called a Yvels. Raced in Paris in 1923.



Not forgetting names like Laverda, Motto Guzi, Puch, Bultaco Metrella and Villa made in 1987 by two Italian brothers Walter & Francesco Villa, previously from the late Brian Verralls collections.



Also on show is a collection of items from the bygone years, many of which are from the railways and pieces which were brought to the town by the migrants, like a 1908 vacuum cleaner, locks, lamps and an original White Star Line First class Egg cup, of which exactly the same were used in the a'la carte dining on board the Titanic.



Accommodation is available in the Historic mens prayer room called Tennyson Hall, built in 1913 by Mr Tennyson and his men. Sure to be a delightful stop over.
